



Papillo-Foveal Bundle Defect: A Course Timeline in Optic Neuritis

A 40-year-old man presented with sequential vision loss in the right (**A**) followed by the left eye (**B**). His right eye had temporal disc pallor with retinal nerve fiber layer defect of the papillo-foveal bundle (**A, C**, arrow). His left eye showed acute papillitis, Paton's lines, and fluid in the papillo-foveal bundle (**B, D**, arrow), due to which a similar papillo-foveal bundle defect is expected in this eye as well when the acute inflammatory episode resolves. Atypical optic neuritis has bilateral involvement, one eye followed by the other eye over a varied span of time. The montage shows the natural timeline of the disease in a single-timeframe snapshot.
