



Pseudotriplex of Optic Disc

Fundus examination of a 34-year-old woman showed a large disc, inferior disc coloboma, and 2 well-circumscribed retinochoroidal colobomas of approximately the size of optic disc, located inferior to the disc, giving an impression of triple optic disc in the right eye. The inferior retinal vessels passed over the choroidal coloboma below the disc and around the coloboma below it. The 2 choroidal colobomatous lesions did not have any vessels originating from them. This case shows an anomaly of 2 retinochoroidal coloboma lying adjacent to each other and below the optic disc, simulating triplex of optic disc.
